Message from Fr Gabriel

This Sunday is the International Day of Prayer for Eastern Christians. It reminds us, in this season of Eastertide as we listen to the Acts of the Apostles, of the Churches that first heard and passed on the Gospel. These churches nowadays are often oppressed and persecuted, and struggle to survive and pass on the faith to their children, in the lands where Christianity was born and first spread. The Eastern Christians are direct descendants of the Early Christians, and there are more than 25 million living in the Middle East and surrounding regions. They were the origins of the monastic tradition, the early Church Fathers and our link to the first teachings of the apostles. We are invited to pray with and for them and so stand in solidarity and communion with them:

Heavenly Father, we pray today for peace in the world, especially in the Middle East and *Ukraine.* By your heavenly grace, strengthen the faith and hope of Eastern Christians. May they be blessed with peace and prosperity in their countries. May we be inspired by their devotion and witness to the Gospel, by their love and compassion for all in their communities, and by their courage, their endurance and self-sacrifice. Through their charity, tolerance and friendship, bring peace and reconciliation to those troubled lands, where Christianity was born and first spread. This we ask through Christ our Lord. Amen.

These times of prayer will bring graces and blessings to us all. Each Sunday there is Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament with Evening Prayer at St John the Baptist from 4pm to 5pm.

Ecumenical Pilgrimage Walk led by the Bishop of Chichester - Saturday 11 May 1pm-5pm

All are warmly invited to join this ecumenical pilgrimage, walking from Hove to Kemptown, to learn about six unique places of worship and their role in our city's past and present. This walking pilgrimage will be led by the Bishop of Chichester, Rt Revd Dr Martin Warner, who will give a short reflection at each place of worship bringing together our historic urban journey, and our contemporary spiritual journey.

The pilgrimage will begin at the ancient parish church of Hove, St Andrew, and progress along the seafront to Holland Road Baptist church, St Paul's on West Street, the Friends' Meeting House, and Dorset Gardens Methodist church. The walk will conclude at St John the Baptist, with a celebration of ecumenical Vespers and refreshments. Whatever your background, you are welcome to come and walk in good company, and see Brighton and Hove from the perspective of a pilgrim.

We meet at 12.30pm at St Andrew's Hove for a 1pm start, and the day concludes with Vespers at 5pm at St John the Baptist. Water, snacks and comfortable shoes are advised, to sustain you on your journey.
