Message from Fr Kieron

We are here today because we have made a choice. For many of us, the original choice was made for us when we were infants, but at some point we have owned it with an adult faith. Others have come to their own faith decision later in life, but either way, past choices have to be kept alive by new commitment. We are still confronted with the same basic choice as were the people of Israel at Shechem and the disciples after the Bread of Life discourse: Do we follow the one true God or choose some other way? Joshua and Peter both offered strong leadership and we look for the same today, but ultimately, it is down to us, we have the freedom to continue to make that choice; because a choice without freedom is no choice at all.

When we celebrate the Liturgy together, we embrace that choice once more with renewed commitment. This is the commitment to *taste and see that the Lord is good* and to bring his goodness into our lives and everyday choices. Occasionally, this may lead to great acts of courage and heroism, but it is more likely to be lived out in being faithful to the Lord in the daily struggles of life, where there are so many competing attractions and temptations. In any case, this high calling—our choice of God and God's choice of us means acting with integrity.

In other words, doing the right thing, even when nobody is looking.


